	HIT Governance Update	
	Georgia Maheras provided an update on the work that AOA was doing to create a proposal to make	
	recommendations around HIT governance. This was done as part of the HIT Strategic Planning effort, relating to	
	the structure of governance in this area and how to make it better. The goal is to provide a more coordinated	
	effort across all involved in HIT in Vermont. Thanks to all of those who participated in the working group who	
	helped to create the recommendations.	
	A summary:	
	 Have AOA chair a group, more weighted toward the private sector, with state officials acting in Ex Officio capacity. 	
	 The group will have sub-groups to address data standards, consent and privacy and technical analysis of systems across the state. 	
	 The group will also offer recommendations about collaborations and adherence to standards and ensure efficiency and alignment as HIT projects move forward. 	
	 The structure is not designed to replace governance that already exists in various agencies or organizations, but to offer a federated model to develop recommendations.

3. Consent Follow	Larry Sandage led a discussion of some follow up items from a presentation that was made in October around	
up	Consent. He reviewed the materials in Attachment 3 of the materials packet, <u>linked here</u> .	
	Additional review of the Consent SOW was conducted to come up with additional recommendations in this area:	
	The State of Vermont, in collaboration with the Vermont Information Technology Leaders (VITL), wishes to	
	implement a Clinical Consent Management solution for the Vermont Health Information Exchange (VHIE).	
	The idea is to allow the functionality to be available through VITLAccess. The scope is meant to be broad	
	so as not to be solution-driven.	
	 Mike Gagnon added that a further goal is to allow better consent architecture to support more granular 	
	options around consent for patient data in the system.	
	Paul Harrington asked if the proposal replaces the "Opt-in" policy that is in place at this time. No, that is	
	not the goal. Georgia added that another goal of this project is to address the operational concerns in this	
	area and not to modify the policy. Should there be an issue with the policy, that would be identified and follow the customary process for the consent policy process.	
	 It was noted that focus has been placed on the role of the user in this analysis, and as a result of this, the 	
	scope of the project has been increased somewhat.	
	Additional recommendations include:	
	 As consent is referenced in statute as being both affiliated with the VHIE and the Blueprint, both 	
	should be considered within the scope of this SOW.	
	This project will proceed with a Request for Information (RFI), developed in collaboration with	
	VITL, the State, and other interested stakeholders. o The SOW intends to provide a basic solution which meets the fundamental needs of the VHIE.	
	O The SOW intends to provide a basic solution which meets the fundamental needs of the VHIE. However, the RFI will request that the proposed solution providers have the capability to both be	
	scalable and provide advanced functionality in possible future iterations.	
4. Sustainability	Georgia Maheras presented a first draft of the SIM Sustainability Plan (here, summarized in Attachment 4).	
Plan	 This is a draft developed based on recommendations of a private-sector stakeholder group. 	
	For activities that are proposed to continue, the Lead Entity will provide stewardship and ownership. They	
	do not have sole decision-making, but should work with Key Partners.

	 The Sustainability Plan is due to CMMI on June 30, 2017. It is a required deliverable of the SIM grant. Comments have been provided to the project team and the draft document has been revised to include suggestions, such as to incorporate more focus on consumer engagement across all of the focus areas. 	To what degree is the legislature involved in SIM sustainability planning? To the extent that the SIM project has been providing updates, testimony and quarterly reports to the legislature that will continue next year. As well, to the degree that there is feedback from that body, it will be incorporated into the final draft.

The original charter was created and the HDI work group has met its goals.
