AMENDMENT

It is agreed by and between the State of Vermont, Department of Vermont Health Access (hereafter called the "State") and Burns & Associates (hereafter called the "Contractor") that the contract on the subject of Medicaid payment systems consulting, effective September 24, 2010, is hereby amended effective November 21, 2014, as follows:

- 1. By deleting Section 3 (Maximum Amount) on page 1 of 12 the base agreement, as previously changed by amendments 1, 2 & 3 and substituting in lieu thereof the following Section 3:
 - 3. <u>Maximum Amount.</u> In consideration of the services to be performed by Contract, the State agrees to pay Contractor, in accordance with the payment provisions specified in Attachment B, a sum not to exceed \$1,833,610. See Attachment B, #1, FUNDING and PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AUTHORIZATON REQUIREMENT.
- 2. By deleting Section 4 (Contract Term) on page 1 of 12 the base agreement, as previously changed by amendments 1, 2 & 3 and substituting in lieu thereof the following Section 4:
 - **4.** <u>Contract Term.</u> The period of Contractor's performance shall begin on September 24, 2010 and end on March 31, 2015. See Attachment B, #1, FUNDING and PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AUTHORIZATON REQUIREMENT.
- 3. By striking out attachment B of the base agreement in the in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof:

ATTACHMENT B PAYMENT PROVISIONS

The maximum dollar amount payable under this agreement is not intended as any form of a guaranteed amount. The Contractor will be paid for products or services actually performed as specified in Attachment A up to the maximum allowable amount specified in this agreement. State of Vermont payment terms are Net 30 days from date of invoice, payments against this contract will comply with the State's payment terms. The payment schedule for delivered products, or rates for services performed, and any additional reimbursements, are included in this attachment. The following provisions specifying payments are:

- FUNDING and PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AUTHORIZATON REQUIREMENT: This
 contract is partially funded by federal grants and is subject to federal approval. No
 reimbursement shall be provided under this agreement without federal approval for the task,
 service, or product for which reimbursement is claimed.
 - a. Funding for this contract has been approved through December 31, 2014 for SIM Task XVI in the amount of \$50,000. Contractor is authorized to conduct work through December 31, 2014 for this task.
 - b. Funding for this contract has been approved through December 31, 2014 for ICD10 Task XIV in the amount of \$30,000. Contractor is authorized to conduct work through December 31, 2014 for this task.
 - c. Funding for this contract has been approved through March 31, 2015 for SIM Task XVI in the amount of \$45,000. Contractor is authorized to conduct work through December 31, 2015 for this task.
 - d. In November, 2014 federal approval was sought for the time period of January 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015 in the amount of \$45,000 for SIM Task XVI. Contractor may not begin work on SIM Task XVI for year two, beginning January 1, 2015 and ending March 31, 2015, without written authorization from the State of Vermont. Approval for year two funding is contingent upon Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation authorization.
- 2. Contractor invoices shall be submitted monthly and shall include the following information:
 - a. The cost and amount of time (number of hours) and costs, including salary and fringe benefits, for each individual involved in this project.
 - b. Detailed descriptions and line item costs associated with all non-personnel items, including data, travel, overhead and any other items necessary for the completion of the project.

- c. The number of trips to Vermont, including the estimated number of people participating
- d. The numbers of days Contractor staff were onsite in Vermont.
- 3. Contractor bills monthly for work done each month, there are no monthly minimums or maximums. If Contractor doesn't do any work in a given month, the State shall not be charged.
- 4. No benefits or insurance will be reimbursed by the State.
- 5. Work conforming to the requirements of Attachment A as reflected in the in tables on page 3 of 3 of this amendment that was performed on or after October 22, 2014, may be reimbursed under this agreement.
